Drug and Alcohol Policy

The possession, purchase or use of alcohol or recreational drugs (also including prescription drugs if they are taken in a manner contrary to labeling) is strictly prohibited throughout the entirety of the Juneau Icefield Research Program. This policy is in effect during the in-town portions of the Program as well during the time on the Icefield. This policy is relevant for ALL participants of the Program. Violation of this policy will result in disciplinary action, up to and including expulsion from the Program and immediate removal from the Icefield at the participant's expense.

Prohibited Activities
